Perform on-site inspection and contract administration duties on MTO highway construction projects at a Senior Inspector level (rcsi) per the MTO Construction Administration Tasks and Specifications (CAIS/CAITM) requirements

Maintain daily documentation of contractor work and contract progress in MTO online Contract Management System referring to the appropriate Contract Administration specifications, milestones, etc., promptly and accurately

Read and apply contract drawings, tender documents, Ontario Provincial Standards (OPS), etc., applicable to the site operation and ensure the contractor adheres to all contract requirements Ensure approved construction materials are used and conduct material sampling for Quality Assurance testing

Ensure appropriate traffic control measures by the contractor are in place in accordance with OTM Book 7 requirements and the Contract documents

Prepare and maintain clear and concise field notes and site plans/sketches

Communicate with colleagues, clients, contractors, and other regulatory agencies and/or stakeholders

Work with Microsoft Word, Excel, AutoCAD and other computer software

Prepare technical emails, letters, reports, meeting minutes, etc.

Complete field safety meetings, conduct work safely and maintain company equipment

Requirements:

Diploma or degree in Civil Engineering and possess OACETT Road Construction Senior Inspector (rcsi) designation or equivalent

Possess a valid driver's license

Experience inspecting highway construction projects or similar type of work
